### **FIRST DAY, SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 6, 2015**

#### **19.00 – 19.45**

- **Welcome words**

After the official welcome words from the representatives of Meeting-host University (University of Belgrade) and Project Coordinator University (State University of Novi Pazar), the participants done bilateral and multilateral conversations and discussions. Also, the participants got formal organizational inputs for the meeting.

### **SECOND DAY, MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 7, 2015**

#### **9.00 – 13.00**

- **Presentations and discussions — Chairs: Professor Dr. Maja Todorović and Professor Dr. Božidar Stanić**

Prof. Dr. Božidar Stanić, Doc. Dr. Edin Dolićanin, State University of Novi Pazar:

Summary of past and current ENERESE activities and activities at State University of Novi Pazar

- Actual Project Reports have made in accordance of project-packages and they are available on Project web-site
- Review current situation per WB region countries: all countries have completed subject Curriculum, first generation of students have completed two years program (it was held at SUNP) and some students started preparation Master Thesis work
- Students and professors exchanges between WB and EU universities has done
- Request for time extension of the project has submitted, however the partners should prepare the final reports

Delegation from University of Niš, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering led by Prof. Dr. Vlasta Nikolić: They are ready for the beginning of the Program; as well as other Universities in Serbia, contribution on the joint structure of the future joint ENERESE programme – combining teaching staff, laboratory equipment and infrastructure; they have done procurement of the laboratory equipment

Prof. Dr. Maja Todorović, University of Belgrade, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering: They are preparing for the Master Program; two-language diploma will be provided for graduated students; they have prepared study material and completed procurement of the laboratory equipment together with Faculty of Civil Engineering and Faculty of Architecture.

Prof. Dr. Radenko Pejović, University of Montenegro, Faculty of Civil Engineering said it was big interest of the students at the beginning and for the second generation is little bit decreased. They have done procurement of the laboratory equipment. Representative of Montenegrin Ministry for Economy expressed his satisfaction for the realization of ENERESE project.

Prof. Dr. Petar Gvero, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, University of Banjaluka: He presented the review with the expectation that Master Program subject will be useful heaving in mind wider framework for energy efficiency in Republic of Srpska. He underlined compliance with project SD TRAIN, that is realizing in WB region. They have done procurement of the laboratory equipment in spite a lot of administrative obstacles.

Prof. Dr. Mustafa Hrasnica, Faculty of Civil Engineering, University of Sarajevo: He presented overview of the University of Sarajevo and the study programmes of the Faculty of Civil Engineering. They will use common project results with some differences adapted to Bosnia and Herzegovina specificities and current circumstances at their Faculty. They have done procurement of the laboratory equipment in spite a lot of administrative obstacles.

After this presentations discussion about the regional specificities has done.

Prof. Dr. Božidar Stanić, State University of Novi Pazar has stressed cooperation and experience exchange between WB universities and EU universities that are ENERESE project partners; common courses are one of the most useful opportunities.

Prof. Dr. Jan Bujnak, University of Zilina, Department of Civil Engineering, expressed satisfaction of his university due to contribution to the project in accordance with Project work packages.

Prof. Dr. Agis M.Papadopoulos, Dept. of Mechanical Engineering, Aristotle University Thessaloniki was interested is there possible to get project extension in order to organize one meeting more. He said the cooperation in the project was usefule for EU universities, too.

Nicoleta Gurita, Research Associate, Technische Universität Bergakademie Freiberg: it is agreed the cooperation between the representatives of WB and EU universities will be mutually useful in a future activities.

Prof. Dr. Miloš Banjac, Assistant Minister of Ministry of Mining and Energy of Republic of Serbia held the short presentation about former and current activities of the Ministry from the field of energy efficiency and renewable energy sources.

Rusmira Mandić, Chamber of Commerce County of Sarajevo said the topic of energy efficiency is very actual in Sarajevo region and companies are interested for it.

Jasmin Delimedjac, SUNP, Project Finance Officer: made short review of finance situation till now, with presentation of tables of costs, expenditures etc; he explained some details that was interested for other participants in the meeting.

After the discussions the participants visited two laboratories at the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering – Belgrade, Laboratory for Automatic Control and Laboratory for Combustion Process.
