During the discussion the following issues were placed keynote speakers;

1. Is this master program is intended only for civil engineers and architecture

Professor Doličanin gave the answer in line with the objectives of the project

2. Why is unexpectedly low interest of students for the master study in Sarajevo?

Civil Engineering Faculty in Sarajevo has a problem with low interest of students who finish primary studies at Bologna 3 + 2 rule. In this respect the round table developed and specific discussions, and, with the expectation that the labor market in the field of EE and RES will continue to increase, one of the conclusions of this meeting and that it was necessary to work on strengthening the interest in this type of study and synergy connect higher education institutions (Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, Faculty of Civil Engineering, Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Environment) to develop a unique program that will be acceptable to the Bologna system of education in BiH, with the adoption of a national qualifications framework. In addition, the project ENERESE has the possibility that 30% of the curriculum of studies into line with the national labor market needs.

3. Owners of companies are interested in hiring professionals with a broad multidisciplinary knowledge that they can perform multiple tasks.

The current legislation for the accreditation of companies for performing energy audits of buildings insists on the involvement of graduate engineers. Therefore this study program in Bosnia and Herzegovina must be based on students who BSc. who will have this expert study and be competitive in the labor market.

Attention was drawn to the adoption of the Law on Energy Efficiency FBiH, and its implementation will result in job creation for energy managers, specialists, etc. in the administration, public companies, companies engaged in the production of renewable energy and others.

Also University must recognize their interest in the establishment of the study and identification of titles.

The conclusion is
